In this session, the LRS Web Solutions team will provide an overview of usability, accessibility, and other important factors to consider when developing or updating a web site. They will also showcase current LRS pension fund customers' websites.

□ **Product Lab** *[to be held on the optional 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the conference]*

Are you curious about enhancements to the PensionGold products? This is your chance to get hands-on experience. Workstations have been set up so you can get a first-hand view of the new functionality. Take some time to explore PensionGold Version 3. We will have members of our Product Development team and our Product Support team on hand and available to assist you and answer your questions. If you have questions or need help learning about any PensionGold features, use the lab time to explore the *product* with your favorite Retirement Solutions staff member.

□ **"Impact of the Pandemic on Retirement System Operations" (Panel Discussion)**

With the nationwide quarantine in the rearview mirror, our Panel Discussion will focus on how the pandemic impacted our customers' business operations. We will cover lessons learned, outcomes (positive or negative), new or modified policies, temporary and permanent changes to overall operations, etc. Three customer panelists will share information from their organizations, and the moderator, John Katalinich, will be encouraging input and discussion from the audience.

□ **Campus Tours**
