

HOTEL TO LRS CAMPUS


- 1. Go West on E. Adams toward S. 7th

Frequently Asked Questions

Where are the conference sessions held?

Day 1 (Oct. 8) and Day 3 (Oct. 10) sessions take place at the LRS campus in Springfield, at 2401 W. Monroe Street. All Day 2 (Oct. 9) sessions will be held in the lower level of the Bank of Springfield (BOS) Center next door to the conference hotel. You can access the BOS Center from inside the conference hotel; ask for guidance at the front desk. If you are driving to the BOS Center from a different hotel, navigate to: 1 Convention Center Plaza, Springfield, IL 62701. Street parking is free; Plaza Parking Garage is also available for \$7/day (entrances on 7th Street and on Washington Street).

How do I connect to the LRS Wi-Fi?

Wi-Fi is available throughout the LRS campus. Join the "LRSGuest" network by using self-registration with your email address or cell phone number. After you enter the registration code, which is 1979, you will receive login credentials.

How do I download the mobile app?

Stay up to the minute with our mobile app, powered by Guidebook. Scan the QR code below, or navigate to https://builder.guidebook.com/g/2024pgtc/ on your mobile device and use the passphrase "pgtc2024".



Is there a shuttle between the conference hotel and LRS?

Yes! For those of you who need a way to get to the LRS campus from the conference hotel on Day 1 and Day 3, we provide a shuttle van that will run between LRS and the DoubleTree - President Abraham Lincoln Hotel. There are scheduled pickups and drop-offs for Days 1 and 3 (see Pg. 5). You can locate the shuttle outside the main entrance at the conference hotel and outside Building 5 on the LRS campus. Jump on the shuttle if you need a ride; seats are available on a first come, first served basis.

Is there a shuttle between the Springfield airport and the conference hotel?

Yes! If you need a ride from the Abraham Lincoln Capital Airport to the conference hotel, please call the hotel at 217-544-8800 as soon as you arrive at the airport and request a shuttle pickup. If you are arriving on Monday, another option is to contact John Katalinich at 217-836-2767 to get a ride via the LRS shuttle van. (Both of these options are also available for getting back to the airport later in the week.)

Is there a dress code?

The short answer is "no", but we can offer some general guidance. For the daytime sessions on Day 1 and Day 2, most attendees typically wear business casual attire. You might consider bringing along a light jacket or sweater, as room temperatures vary. The evening reception on Day 1 will be more relaxed with a casual dress code, and we encourage you to show your team spirit by wearing your favorite sports team apparel to go along with our "tailgating" theme. (Note: Day 3 is a travel day for many attendees; casual clothing is fine.)

Where is the Internet Café?

If you need a laptop, printer, or phone charger during your time at LRS during the PensionGold Teaming Conference, you are welcome to use the Internet Café located just outside the Auditorium in the Building 5 Atrium.

Where can I park my vehicle?

If you drive to the LRS campus versus taking our shuttle from the conference hotel, please park at 2451 W. Monroe Street (watch for our PensionGold Teaming Conference parking signs). This is the surface parking lot just outside of LRS Building 6. Note that conference registration and check-in are located in LRS Building 5 at 2401 W. If you don't stay at the conference hotel and you drive to the BOS Center for the Day 2 sessions, you may park on the street (which is free) or in the Plaza Parking Garage for \$7/day (entrances on 7th Street and on Washington Street).
